As a member you are entitled to many privileges, some of which are listed below:-

- Membership of the N.A.P.G.C. and the E.G.U.
- An official handicap is available when 3 cards are completed in club competitions. Club competitions can be entered by placing your name on competition entry forms, these are displayed on the club notice board. The draw for each competition is made 10 days beforehand and is pinned up in the cabinet so that you can check that you have been entered. Those who already have a handicap from a previous club need to produce a handicap certificate from their previous club and give it to the handicap secretary.
- Once a handicap is gained members can be entered to qualify for finals at other events under the N.A.P.G.C. and E.G.U. at other courses.
- Play for the club in matches against other clubs.
- Attend social functions that are arranged, information on these events can be found on the club notice board.
